<p style="text-align: center; font-weight: bold; margin: 0;">PLAN</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • WHAT I’ll do • DATE and TIME • WHERE & HOW I’ll get there • WHAT I need to take with me • Plan ahead for things that might get in the way: 	<p>To Do #1 <u><i>Earn extra money</i></u></p> <p><i>At noon work break tomorrow, tell Rene and Allison that I’m looking for extra time</i></p> <p><i>Remind them first Monday of every month</i></p>	<p>To Do #2 <u><i>Get There</i></u></p> <p><i>This Friday after work, text Al about borrowing money for tickets.</i></p> <p><i>Ask Al to borrow money to get car looked over.</i></p> <p><i>Call Mel’s aunt to thank her for staying there one night.</i></p>	<p>To Do #3 <u><i>Get time off</i></u></p> <p><i>Next Monday (my day off) change any appts I have over the next couple of months, so I don’t need to miss any work</i></p> <p><i>After the car is checked, send an email to my supervisor asking for Spring break week off. Offer to work extra ‘til then.</i></p>
	<p><i>If the car isn’t going to make it, then I’ll plan to go the first week after school instead.</i></p>		
	<p>My reward for success: <i>Seeing my boy happy (and maybe having some ice cream with him!)</i></p>

Put a picture of my mom in Robert’s room so he gets energy around it.</i></p> <p><i>Tell people what I’m doing so they’ll support me. Tell my mom I’m coming so I don’t change my mind too easily.</i></p>
